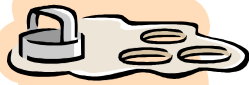

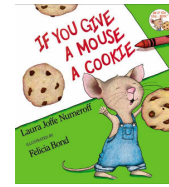




# July Storytime

Saturday, July 9 10:30-11am

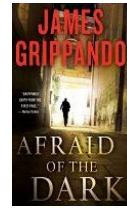
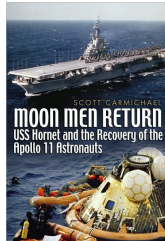
